Stage	Details
1. Written Test	AISSEE written exam (OMR) conducted by NTA in January
2. Merit List	State-wise & category-wise merit list released by Sainik Schools Society
3. Medical Exam	Shortlisted candidates undergo medical fitness test at Army/Navy/AF hospitals
4. Final Selection	Based on written marks + medical fitness; admission offered to qualified candidates

Preparation Tips

Mathematics: Focus on NCERT Class 4 & 5. Practise at least 30 problems daily. Master BODMAS, fractions and mensuration first.

General Knowledge: Read a children's GK book + daily newspaper headlines. Maintain a current-affairs diary for the last 6 months.

Language: Read English passages daily; practise grammar from Class 4-5 NCERT. For Hindi, focus on Vyakaran (grammar) and comprehension.

Mock Tests: Solve previous-year AISSEE papers under timed conditions. Aim for at least one full-length mock per week.

Time Management: 150 min for 100 Qs = 90 sec/question. Attempt Maths last if needed; GK & Language are faster.
